

Sky-Y Adventure Catalina Island and Disney 2008 Summer Equipment List

Necessities

Sleeping Bag and Pillow

Sleeping Pad (foam or thermarest type)

Long Pants and Shorts

1 warm long sleeved fleece or sweater.

1 or 2 sweatshirts

1 warm hat (*it can get cold at night on the island*)

Socks

Bathing Suit (*appropriate coverage needed, no speedos or small bikinis.*)

Sunscreen and a Hat

Short Sleeve Shirts or T-Shirts

Toiletries and Towels (*having items in travel size containers will be helpful for our Grand Canyon/Flagstaff trip*)

Underclothing

1 Pair of Sneakers, 1 Pair of Sandals

Water bottle or canteen (*Minimum size is 1 liter, please make sure it is not a flimsy throw away type*)

Flashlight and extra batteries (*A head lamp can be very useful but not required*)

Sunglasses and sunscreen

Small daypack/backpack (*to keep personal stuff with you on the bus, and keep personal items with you in Disneyland.*)

Medication (*must be checked in with adventure camp staff*)

Wallet (*one that fits in your pocket so you can carry money around in Disneyland*)

Optional

Wetsuit

Rash Guard (*to wear underneath wetsuit*)

Inexpensive Camera/Film

Stationary/Stamps/Envelopes

Notebook/Pens

Books

Portable CD Players or IPODs (*These will only be allowed for the bus rides only. They will be locked a safe at all other times.*)

Cell phone (*Since we are traveling out of state, campers will be given a specific time to call home to "check-in" at the discretion the Adventure Staff. At all other times they will be locked up*)
