

# Sky-Y Adventure Camps Habitat for Humanity New Mexico 2008 Summer Equipment List

## Necessities

Sleeping Bag (please bring in a stuff sack or compression sack if you have one)

Pillow (*Travel pillows can be nice for the bus ride*)

Sleeping mat (foam or thermarest type)

2 pairs of long pants, 2-3 pairs of shorts (*These should be ones you don't mind getting paint or dirt from construction*)

2 Warm shirts : sweatshirts or sweaters, (*it can get cool at night*)

Socks

Bathing Suit (*appropriate coverage needed, no small bikinis*)

Sunscreen (LOTS OF IT) and a Hat

4 T-Shirts (*These should be ones you don't mind getting paint or dirt from construction*)

Toiletries and 1 towel (*Travel size toiletries are best*)

Underclothing for 10 days

1 emergency poncho, or rain coat

1 Pair of Sneakers, 1 Pair of Sandals with a heel strap (no flip flops for the raft trip)

1 water bottle minimum size 1 liter, nalgene style is the best.

Sunglasses and Sunscreen

Flashlight And Extra Batteries (*a head lamp can be very useful, but is not required*)

Medication (*must be checked in with adventure camp staff*)

A small backpack (*to hold your items on the bus, and at the worksite*)

A positive attitude and willingness to participate in all the responsibilities of camp life

## Optional

Inexpensive Camera/Film

Stationary/Stamps/Envelopes/notebook/pens.

A Good Book to read on the bus ride, or something to keep you busy such as crossword, sudoku etc.

Portable CD Players/CD's or an IPOD (*These will be allowed only on for the bus ride, and will be locked up at all other times*)

Cell Phone (*campers will have specific times to call home to check in, all other times they will be locked up*)

## Do Not Bring

Anything That Needs To Be Plugged In

A rigid suit case (*they make packing the bus difficult, you do not need to fit your sleeping pad and bag in your suit case or duffle bag*)

Anything of Value

Anything Illegal/Camp Inappropriate (*weapons, drugs, alcohol, explicit material, etc...*)

## Spending Money Recommendation

(*a lock box will be provided for the security of camper's money*)
