Check in: YMCA Camp Sky-Y in Prescott AZ, from 1-3:00pm. Campers do have the option of taking the bus from The Christown YMCA for an additional fee of \$65. Check in at the Christown YMCA begins at 11:00am

Check out: YMCA Camp Sky-Y in Prescott AZ, from 9 - 11:00am. Campers can also take the bus back to the Christown YMCA and Pickup is at 12:30pm.

TRIP ITINERARY: July 5th – July 18th, 2009 (Sun-Sat, 2 weeks)

Sunday, July 5th

We will begin our camp with an Adventure Camp Orientation, have dinner, attend Camp Sky-Y Opening Jamboree, and prepare for our week together.

Monday, July 6th

After breakfast we will pack up our gear and food, and head on our Journey to New Mexico's Blue Water Lake State Park. We'll set up camp at the park, cook dinner on our camp stoves, play some games and enjoy the lake, have a campfire and enjoy some s'mores.

Tuesday, July 7th

We will continue our Journey to Taos, New Mexico. In the afternoon we will meet our the Volunteers from Habitat for Humanity, receive an orientation and start work. In the evening we will be spending the night in a nearby Church basement which has a full working kitchen for our cooking needs.

Wednesday July 8th ; Thursday July 9th ; Friday July 10th ; and Saturday, July 11th.

We will spend each day the worksite of a Habitat for Humanity house. Be prepared to get dirty, sweaty, and use a little elbow grease. After each day of work, we will shower at the Taos Youth Center, and then have dinner at our base camp. Evening we will explore what Taos has to offer. Activities may include movies, board-games, ultimate frisbee at the park, roller-skating, bowling, or exploring Historic Taos.

Sunday, July 12th

We'll spend the entire day rafting with Far Flung Adventures on the Rio Grande.

Monday July 13th ; Tue July 14th ; Wed July 15th

We'll continue our work with Habitat for Humanity, and entertainment in the evenings.

Thur July 16th

We'll pack up our gear in the morning, and start our journey back to Blue Water State Park for the evening.

Fri July 17th

We'll finish our journey back to Camp Sky-Y in Prescott. Campers will have an opportunity to participate in activities that the Camp has to offer. These may include: High Ropes course, Giant Swing, Climbing Tower, Swimming pool, Paintball, Mountain Biking, or Mountain Boarding. We'll join the all-camp Pinecone Dedication Ceremony and wrap up our trip.

Wednesday, July 30th

Campers can be picked up at Camp Sky-Y from 9:00-11:00am, or take the bus back to the *Christown YMCA*, and be picked up around 12:30pm.
