

Ultimate California Adventure 2009 Equipment List

Necessities

Sleeping Bag that packs small, stuff sack and pillow.
Sleeping Pad (*foam or thermarest type that rolls up small*)
2 Pair Long Pants and 2 -3 pair Shorts
1 Warm long sleeved fleece, sweater or jacket
1 Sweatshirt
1 Warm hat: (*camping on the beach at night is windy and cool*)
Swim suit (*appropriate coverage needed, inappropriate swimwear will result in having to wear a t-shirt over swimwear*)
Lots of Sunscreen, Sunglasses and a Hat/Visor
1 Large towel, 1 small towel
5-6 T-Shirts or tank tops (*no spaghetti straps or revealing clothes allowed*)
Toiletries (*travel size products only*)
Underclothing and socks for 7 days.
1 Pair of Sneakers
1 Pair of Sandals. (*Flip flops are not allowed in the parks, but can be worn on the bus or in shower*)
Wrist watch (*To keep track of time in the amusement parks*)
1 small trash bag or laundry bag
A few small plastic bags
Water bottle (*Minimum size is 1 liter, please make sure it is not a flimsy throw away type*)
Flashlight and extra batteries (*A head lamp can be very useful but not required*)
Small daypack/backpack (*to keep personal stuff with you on the bus, and keep personal items with you in the parks.*)
Medication that you take (*must be checked in with adventure camp staff*)
Wallet (*one that fits in your pocket so you can carry money around with you in the parks*)
Sack Lunch for the bus ride Sunday.
(Duffle bag or soft bags are preferable to large square suitcases -they pack better on the bus)

Optional

Wetsuit: (*For comfort when surfing/body-boarding*)
Rash guard: (*A thin shirt worn under wetsuit*)
Inexpensive Camera/Film
Travel / Neck Pillow for the bus ride
Book, magazine, notebook and pen, playing cards (*to pass the time on the bus ride*)
Portable Music Players (*These will only be allowed for the bus rides. They will not fit our lock-box, but can be left on the bus which will be locked up*)
Cell phone (*Campers will be given a specific time to call home to "check-in" at the discretion the Adventure Staff. At all other times they will be locked up*)

Do Not Bring

Anything That Needs To Be Plugged In
(Curling irons, hair irons, electric shavers, laptops)
Anything Of Major Value
Matches / Lighter / Pocket Knife.
Anything Illegal / Camp Inappropriate:
(*weapons, tobacco, drugs, alcohol, explicit material, etc...*)
Spaghetti strap tank tops, short shorts, or other inappropriate clothing

Spending Money Recommendation: \$125

Campers are responsible for buying their lunch and dinner at each of the amusement parks. There is also ample opportunity to buy snacks and souvenirs. Minimum amount needed is about \$65 to buy lunch and dinner in each of the parks. (*A lock box will be provided for the security of camper's money*)
