Dear Teen Adventure Travel Campers/Parents,

On behalf of the Adventure camp staff, we would like to welcome you to the program. We are looking forward to your arrival and are excited to begin our adventure together. We have planned a lot of exciting activities for our trips, so be ready to make new friends, and explore new places and exciting things.

Along with this letter you will find an itinerary, equipment list, cell phone policy, and all required forms. Please review the information carefully and complete all the necessary forms. In order for the camper to participate, ALL forms must be completed prior to the trip. Please do not mail forms to camp ahead of time. Participants will be sleeping in tents and the majority of the meals will be prepared at campsites. The key component for a successful trip is for the group to work together as a team, so all campers will share the varied responsibility of camp life.

### A Few Reminders:

1. We will be taking all of our belongings with us for the duration of the adventure trip. Due to limited space in the buses only bring the necessary or suggested items stated on the equipment list. A duffle bag or large back pack is preferable than a large hard suitcase with wheels. The majority of campsites will not have electric outlets so items such as hairdryers and curling irons will not be permitted. Please send plenty of sunscreen!!! If you cannot get any items on the required list, please call us at camp as soon as possible, we do have a few extra items available to borrow.
2. The amount of spending money will depend on which trip you attend. Some trips will require a greater amount of money while others will not. Please refer to the "Spending Money Recommendation" section of the equipment list to see what the appropriate amount would be for your adventure. *Please send money in small bills (5-20's)*
3. Medical forms need to be completed and signed by a doctor. One is included in this mailing along with an over-the-counter medication form. You can also substitute a copy of a recent physical in place of the doctor's signature.
4. If your camper has any medication they will need to be given to the Teen Adventure staff upon check-in. All meds need to be in the original bottle with the campers name clearly on the bottle (for prescriptions)
5. Please take note of our new Cell Phone Policy. Included in this packet.
6. If you have an emergency in which you need to contact your camper, please call the Sky-Y Main office and we will be in contact with the Trip Leaders. 1-800-660-1385
