

YMCA Camp Sky-Y Packing List

NOTE: Participants should be limited to ONE small suitcase or small duffle bag, and 1 large garbage bag for your sleeping bag/pillow.
All items should be marked with your name.

NECESSARY

- ___ 4 changes of underwear
- ___ 4 pairs of socks
- ___ Pajamas
- ___ 1 or 2 pairs of shoes appropriate for walking/hiking around camp.
- ___ 1 emergency poncho or raincoat
- ___ 1 or 2 pairs of long pants or jeans
- ___ 1 or 2 pairs of shorts.
- ___ 1 heavy sweater or sweatshirt (it gets cool at night)
- ___ 1 warm shirt
- ___ 2 T-shirts
- ___ Laundry bag or pillow case for dirty laundry
- ___ Bath towel
- ___ Soap and other toiletries.
- ___ Comb or brush
- ___ Toothbrush & toothpaste
- ___ Sleeping bag or sheet/blanket set
- ___ Pillow
- ___ **Water bottle** (Very important!!)
- ___ Day pack or small back pack
- ___ Flashlight and extra batteries

WINTER ADDITIONS (Nov-March)

- ___ Heavy coat or jacket
- ___ Warm hat
- ___ Mittens or warm gloves
- ___ Extra pair of shoes
- ___ Warm socks (wool or synthetic)
- ___ Extra clothing to wear as layers (all classes are outside)
- ___ Blanket (optional)

OPTIONAL

- ___ reading materials
- ___ writing materials
- ___ plastic bags
- ___ small magnifying glass
- ___ binoculars
- ___ sunglasses
- ___ chap stick
- ___ stamps
- ___ camera & film
- ___ flip flops for the shower
- ___ Tissues
- ___ Watch
- ___ Travel alarm

NOT ALLOWED

CD player (they get lost or broken)
mp3 player (they get lost or broken)
cell phones
knives or other weapons
candy or gum
extra food in your cabin
hair dryers
fireworks
matches
pets

Because of elevation, expect the temperature at Sky-Y to be about 15-20 degrees colder during the day than it would be at home during the same season.

At night temperatures can be 20-25 degrees cooler.
