REMINDERS

Financial Assistance: Based upon available resources, the YMCA is pleased to be able to provide financial assistance for summer programs. Financial aid awards are based on a review of the applicant's income, expenses and extenuating circumstances. **All financial aid applications must be completed and submitted to our office 30 days prior to the desired camp session.** Financial aid applications can be found on our internet sites www.azycamps.org under the camper application and forms or www.valleymca.org under the parent information tab.

Two-Tiered Fee Structure: We have a 2-tiered structure so that our camps are available to ALL families regardless of their ability to pay. The (A) fee represents the "actual cost" of operating camp including overhead, other indirect costs and all direct costs. The (B) fee is partially subsidized fee. Fee B does not cover the entire cost of operation and overhead. It is strictly an "honor system" and you may choose the fee that best fits your family's needs. There is no distinction in the Camp community to who paid what.

Every Camper gets the same level of attention, food, accommodation and Tender-loving care.

Email and Photo service: Email service is again provided by Bunk1 so that parents, grandparents or friends can send one way messages daily. Please refer to the web site for cost.

Open Houses: March 19, April 9, April 30, May 7, May 14 from 10am to 2 pm. Plan to come by and visit the camps, and meet the staff during our Open House dates. Bring friends who haven't made up their minds yet or come on your own... but at least come.
